- ❖ **Local Artichokes** are plentiful in large sizes, however small sizes are limited.
- ❖ **Berry** prices are steady on blacks and blues, Strawberry prices have adjusted down this week making them a good buy. Raspberry pricing has increased due to limited availability.
- ❖ **Avocado** market has adjusted slightly this week.
- ❖ **Celery** prices have spiked yet again this week due to limited supplies as we transition to summer fields.
- ❖ **Lime** prices are on the rise and we anticipate the increases to continue into May.
- ❖ **Melon** prices on cantaloupe are on the rise, fruit from Central America. Consider using CA honeydew and Mexican watermelon.
- ❖ **Onions** last of the shed onions, expect new crops early May. Spring onions gapping this week.
- ❖ **Potato** Yukons, especially Bakers and A's have becoming limited as we ready for the 2019 new crops from Bakersfield in the coming weeks.
