- ❖ Strawberries will be tight this week due to rain damage. Expect rising prices and fragile flesh that breaks down quickly.
- ❖ Fresno chilies have nearly doubled in price. Growing regions in Mexico have cool then normal temperature contributing to slow growth and lower yield.
- ❖ Celery, Brussel Sprouts and Broccoli/Broccolini are all still extreme due to tight supplies from late planting and transitioning fields and now rain delays.
- ❖ Valencia oranges in stock this week.

OVERVIEW & OUTLOOK

Asparagus: Delta Asparagus and Salinas grass both available and California grown.

Avocados: Avocado market has tightened and Mexico is pushing pricing up this week. We are stocking 48 count from California and both California and Mexico 60 count.

Bell Peppers: Prices are steady on all colors.

Bananas: Prices are steady.

Berries – Strawberries: Prices have continued to drop, however rains predicted for Northern California this week may effect supply and price later in the week.

Broccoli / Broccolini: Prices continue to be high as products are still limited. Market remains strong.

Brussel Sprouts: Price is extreme. Small sizing, coming from Mexico.

Celery: Still a limited crop and prices remain high.

Citrus – Lemons: All CA product.

Citrus - Oranges: Juicing oranges are now Valencia from California.

Corn: California corn available from the desert. Check back for an update on Brentwood season, rains delaying harvest.

Cucumber: Prices are steady.

Eggs: Prices have dropped again this week. Recommended good buy.

Lettuces: Romaine, Greenleaf and Gem lettuces all priced well. Recommended good buy.

Melon: melon pricing is steady this week.

Stone-fruit: Cherries are now available. Prices are high on #1 fruit. Early peaches, apricots and nectarines from California's Central Valley are available. Call your Sales Representative to learn more.

Tomatoes: Prices are steady and color has improved.
