- ❖ **Raspberries** and **Blackberries** continue to be very limited and prices remain high this week. Fruit is still coming from Georgia and Mexico. We are expecting to see California product in the upcoming weeks.
- ❖ First crop **Onions** are showing thin skin and strong smell. As they cure, quality and shelf life will improve.
- ❖ **Brussel Sprouts** prices remain high this week as we switch from Mexico to crops from California Central Valley.
- ❖ **Bluelake, Yellow Wax** and **Romano beans** are now coming from **Dwelley Farms** in Brentwood, CA **White** and **Yellow Corn** from this farm also available.

Avocados: Both 48 and 60 count from California available.

Bell Peppers: Prices are steady.

Bananas: Prices are steady.

Berries: Strawberries – Recommended good buy.

Berries: Raspberries and Blackberries – Prices remain high this week and crops are limited.

Broccoli–Cauliflower: Prices have dropped. Recommended good buy.

Citrus: Lemons – Prices are steady.

Citrus - Oranges: Juicing oranges are now all Valencia from California. Naval season has ended.

Corn: California yellow and white corn available from Dwelley Farms.

Cucumber: Prices are steady.

Eggplant: Prices remain high this week due to limited availability on #1 product.

Eggs: Prices are steady.

Greens: Spring mix, spinach, arugula, and baby kale all steady.

Lettuce: Iceberg Lettuce- Prices are going up this week.

Melon: Most Melons are from California crops.

Potatoes: Large Russet potatoes-50-60-70 ct prices are elevated.

Squash: Zucchini and Yellow squash are steady. Recommended good buy this week.

Stonefruit: Early peaches and nectarines from California's Central Valley are available. Prices remain high and early fruits may present a low brix. Cherries also available, but limited and high priced. Call your Sales Representative to learn more

Tomatoes: Prices are up slightly this week. Local heirlooms and specialty tomatoes are predicted to start late this year due to cooler weather.
