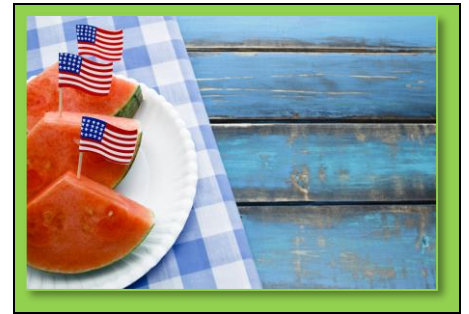

- ❖ We are starting to see some relief on **Avocado** prices. Chilean avocados available this week for a more convenient price. However, flavor and texture are different.
- ❖ **Lemons** remain a strong market and prices are still high. However, prices are starting to adjust down.
- ❖ **Asparagus** prices remain high this week due to weather issues in the growing regions of Mexico. Expect mixed sizing and quality issues.

Apples: Organic Gravenstein apples now available. Ideal for apple sauces, pies and ciders.

Brussel Sprouts: Local Brussel Sprout season is back! We are now seeing product from Giusti Farms in Half Moon Bay.

Bell Peppers: Prices are steady.

Bananas: Prices are steady.

Berries: Strawberries – prices are slightly up Coming from Watsonville.

Blueberries – Prices are up this week.

Raspberries and Blackberries – Prices are high this week.

Carrots: Prices are steady.

Cauliflower: Prices are increasing this week.

Cilantro: Prices are starting to adjust down.

Citrus: Lemons- Strong market. Prices are starting to adjust down.

Limes – Prices are remain high this week.

Corn: California yellow and white corn available from Brentwood.

Eggplant: Prices are up this week.

Figs: Black Mission Figs and Calimyrna figs still available. Take advantage of them before the season ends!

Greens: Spring mix, spinach, arugula, and baby kale prices are steady. Expect some quality issues in Spinach caused by weather extremes.

Lettuce: Romaine prices are steady. For a good value purchase, we suggest trying 12/3 Romaine Hearts from Field Fresh.

Melon: Most Melons are from California crops. Season is coming to an end.

Onions: Prices are steady.

Squash: Zucchini and Yellow squash prices are slightly up this week. Happy Boy mixed toybox also available. Call your sales rep for more info.

Stonefruit: We are nearing the end of stone fruit season. Plums still available.

Tomatoes: Prices are up across the board. Happy Boy Hierloom still available.
