- ❖ **Baby Gems, Butter lettuce** and **Living Butter Lettuce** are slightly up this week due to a lack of availability of product.
- ❖ **Red Bell Peppers** continue to be limited and prices remain high. New crops of green bells are being harvested right now not allowing the time for the peppers to ripe into red. This situation is expected to improve as we advance into the season.

Berries: Strawberries are starting to adjust down as product from Baja California becomes available. Raspberries continue to be high. Blueberries & Blackberries are steady.

Broccoli: Prices are steady. Crops have slowed down as fields are experiencing lower yields, lighter weights and off quality.

Brussel Sprouts: Local product available.

Cauliflower: Prices have continued to drop this week. Recommended good buy.

Citrus: Lemons & Limes – Prices are steady
Oranges – If you are looking for a sweeter blend, ask your sales rep about a 50/50 alternative.

Eggplant: Recommended good buy this week.

Greens: Romaine & Iceberg lettuces are showing good prices this week. On the other hand, baby gems, butter lettuce and living butter lettuce are slightly up due to lack of availability.

Melon: Melons are all from Mexico. Prices are steady.

Onions: Prices are steady.

Peppers: Red Bell Peppers prices continue to be high this week. On the other hand, Green Bells are slightly down.

Squash: Hard squashes still available. Perfect for hearty winter meals.
